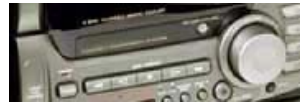

New technology for policing the highways

ALBERTA/630 CHED - Infrared technology is being tested to detect unsafe commercial vehicles on the province's highways.

The system can detect problems with brakes and tires, along with improperly loaded trucks and even false compartments used to smuggle drugs. Rob Sapinsky, co-ordinator for Commercial Vehicle Enforcements Thermal Eye Unit, tested the province's only unit earlier this week in Grande Prairie, Alta.

The gadget is also used by the Canadian military and certain police helicopters.

It is 98 per cent accurate, which means that nearly every truck singled out for further inspection is potentially dangerous.
